

Interview with Clif Wagner

January 5, 2021

- worked at GOREC for 20+ years, while it was a boy scout camp and during transition. Just retired this year.
- Peak summer – 200 boy scouts, 7 weeks in the summer, until 2015/2016
- 2016-2019 – rented cabins and campgrounds, but activity was reduced. Campground saw limited use
- Campground had 11 sites with 25-35 kids at each site during pre-2015. In 2015, platforms were removed and reduced number of campsites to about 15 individual sites total.
- Boy scouts continue to come and use cabins.
- Water use – pre 2015 – heavy use, including canoes, kayaks, sailboats, swimming instruction, and docks. Much of this has been removed since then and activity has been reduced.
